FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF GRAND MOUND”**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Grand Mound, Iowa in Clinton County, Iowa:

The following persons and positions named shall be paid the wages indicated and the Clerk, Mayor or Mayor Pro-Tem are authorized to issue checks, less legally required or authorized deductions from the amounts set out below and make such contributions to IPERS, Social Security, or other purposes as required by law or authorization of the Council all subject to audit and review by the Council:

**Full Time City Maintenance, Joseph Miller \$20.00 per hour  
Effective 12/12/2022**

The employee will be eligible for \$. 50 per license upon completion of the required grade one certifications for water treatment, water distribution and wastewater treatment effective the date of certification.


The employee is required to sign a two year contract with the city stipulating if the employee were to resign within two years of hire, the employee would be responsible to reimburse the city for the cost of the classes and testing required to complete the water and wastewater grade one certifications and the cost of obtaining a CDL if the employee chooses not to pay to obtain a CDL on their own.
