**“A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAX PROPERTY TAX LEVY RATE FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2022 FOR THE CITY OF GRAND MOUND”**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Grand Mound, Iowa in Clinton County, Iowa:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grand Mound has considered the proposed FY 2022 City maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed City maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on the City website and social media account, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed City maximum property tax dollars was held at 6:50 p.m. on January 11th, 2021

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Grand Mound that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY2022 shall not exceed the following total:

Total Maximum Levy for affected property tax levies: \$226,479.00.

The Maximum Property Tax dollars request in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY2022 does represent an increase of more than 102% from the maximum property tax dollars requested for FY2021.
