



# NOTICE OF STREET and BOULEVARD CLOSURE THE 700 BLOCK OF FULTON STREET

(from Smith Street to East Street)

**SEPTEMBER 12TH, 2022 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 16TH, 2022**

**6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. approximately.**

- ❖ Why? The 700 block of Fulton street will be reshaped, graded, and paved from sidewalk to sidewalk, which includes the parking/boulevard areas. The City is funding the project to address stormwater flow and improve street conditions.
- ❖ Please utilize alley access or an alternative route. We apologize for any inconvenience.
- ❖ **No parking on the boulevard.** Every effort will be made to work with property owners to have vehicles moved, however if an owner cannot be located, a tow truck will be required to remove vehicles remaining in the boulevard at the owner's expense.
- ❖ Every effort will be made to give access to property owners of the 700 block of Fulton Street during the construction prep phase (estimated timeframe of 2-3 days Monday-Wednesday).
- ❖ Days 4-5 Paving phase Thursday & Friday: No access can be granted to property owners via the street and an alternative route or alley access will need to be utilized.
- ❖ Garbage, Recycling, and Compost pickup will be the same for this week and may be placed along the boulevard.
