Motion by Banowetz, second by Schanze to authorize BNJ Electric to obtain a final cost summary and purchase 16 trail lights and posts up to the maximum cost estimated provided in the bid. BNJ Electric to store the materials indoors until installation in the spring of 2022. Ayes; All.

Motion by Banowetz, second by Warren to authorize the Health Insurance benefit renewal to provide employees the option to choose between Option A, Wellmark Gold Enhanced Blue 2000 PPO for a family plan with the premium paid by the City, or Option B United Healthcare 2021 BSC6 RX651 Advantage Choice Plus family plan with the difference in premium from Option A to Option B paid by the employee, or Option C, the employee may elect to receive a monthly

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stipend of 65% of the cost of the Employee's Option A's family plan with proof of health insurance coverage. Ayes; All.

Motion by Schaze, second by Beuthien to approve Iowa ABD License # LE0002794 Diva & Tej USA Food & Gas, Ayes; All.

Motion by Banowetz, second by Warren to authorize the Y54 complete street patch by the County with regular C-4 mix. Ayes; All.

Motion by Schanze, second by Beuthien to approve the Visu-Sewer proposal. Ayes; All.

Splash pad options were discussed. Continued discussion to occur in November.

Sidewalk requirements were discussed. The Council will review options for sidewalk programs in the future.

Resolution 21-18 A Resolution to approve the COVID-19 Leave policy was introduced by Schanze with a second by Beuthien. Roll Call: Schanze- Aye, Banowetz- Aye, Warren- Aye, Beuthien- Aye. Mayor Crosthwaite signed the Resolution.

Reports: There are additional pot holes to be filled. The status of the flow meter to be added on the north side was requested. The stop signs and speed limit signs will be added within the next week. A garbage can will be added on the end of the trail near City Hall and options will be reviewed for adding additional garbage cans along the trail. Golf Carts are not authorized to be operated on the trail. Trail signs state no motorized vehicles.
